Anthem of the Seas is designed to provide you with the BEST views possible to get up close and see this massive natural wonder with its 1,350 miles of blue ice. Juneau, the capital of Alaska, was founded during a gold rush in 1880. It is the only state capital in the nation not accessible by road. You can get there only by plane or ship. Today, the former gold-mining town has some of Alaska's most spectacular scenery. Several magnificent fjords are located along the channel coast, and the majestic Mendenhall Glacier is nearby for you to visit. When gold was discovered in the Klondike region of the Yukon Territory, it resulted in the historic Gold Rush of 1898. As thousands of gold-crazed adventurers sought the best starting point for the arduous trek, they found the deepest penetration possible by boat was at the northern tip of the Lynn Canal. This is how Skagway was born. Climb aboard the world-famous White Pass & Yukon Route Railroad for an exciting adventure & one of railway's most popular scenic excursions. Icy Strait Point is located near the city of Hoonah, the largest native Tlingit Indian settlement in Alaska, and near Glacier Bay National Park. Home to the historic cannery, the port's connection to the sea is strong. Locals share the sea with humpback whales, orcas, Dall porpoises, sea otters, seals, halibut and all five species of Pacific salmon. 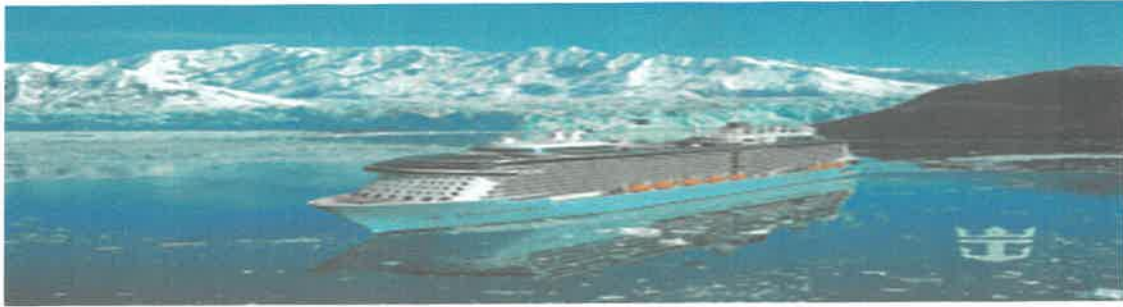
