Providing these designated leaders with the necessary skills and knowledge will build a community where individuals work for the common good and lead Wayne County to a strong and prosperous future.

Expectations:

In every session, each participant should actively engage in discussions and class work and complete outside assignments. Your presence, energy, ideas, and questions are essential to the full WC Leads experience. Candidates MUST have the full support of the organization they represent.

Graduation from WC Leads does not signify an end but represents the beginning of a commitment to civic involvement. Participants are expected to become continually, substantively, and actively engaged within community businesses/organizations in leadership roles. Remember leadership happens at all levels of an organization.

Throughout the WC Leads experience, participants will meet various community leaders to engage who are excited to share valuable information.

Tuition:

Investment of \$750.00 per person for Chamber Members. Non-members may apply to participate; however, tuition will be combined with the cost of a membership with the Wayne County Chamber. Tuition includes entry to the Wayne County Chamber's Next Level workshop and Flavor of Wayne County, Additionally, five (5) sessions, all materials for the program, and reserved seating at the Wayne County Area Chamber of Commerce's Annual Dinner on January 17, 2025, are included in the cost of the program. Upon notification of acceptance in the 2024 Leadership Academy, an invoice will be sent, and tuition will be due by October 2, 2024.



Time Commitment:

Commitment to participating in the Leadership Academy centers on involvement. The classes will begin promptly at 1:00 pm and end at 5:00 pm. The dates for the 2024 Leadership Academy are listed below. Sessions will be held at various locations in the community. **Attendance at all sessions is mandatory.** Participants will be exposed to additional programs and events that can enhance their professional development, but they are not a requirement. The Leadership Academy may excuse absences because of extenuating circumstances. Dismissal from the program can result from unexcused absences.

The Leadership Academy seeks candidates who represent a cross-section of the community and its businesses. Maximum enrollment is 12 participants. Every completed application will be reviewed by a selection committee. The class will include current and emerging leaders. Applicants will be notified by September 9, 2024. Graduates will be officially inducted into the WC Leads alumni group. With so many qualified candidates, selecting this year's class will present a difficult challenge. Individuals who previously applied but were not selected are encouraged to reapply.

- A passion for the people and future of our community, and a personal commitment to help improve the quality of life in Wayne County.
- A demonstrated capacity for leadership within their own organization through significant achievement and experience relative to age.
